



Can I apply for a One Me grant?

What is it for? To assist with financial barriers to access education, training and employment opportunities.

Who can apply? Anyone who is between 16 – 25 years old. You must be 16 or over or 25 and under on the date of your application

Value of Grants: the value of grants made will be between; £100 - £1,000.

Can anyone make an application, for anything?

It is One Me's aim to create a culture that respects and values differences, promotes diversity and equality, and encourages development maximising true potential. Its aim is to remove any barriers, bias or discrimination that prevents individuals or groups from realising their potential. Therefore there are no barriers to applicants; however the application must fulfil one or more of the objects of the Charity which are:

To provide funding for young people between the ages of 16 to 25 living in the United Kingdom to access advice, assistance and programmes of physical, educational and other activities as a means of:

- (a) advancing in life and helping young people by developing their skills, capacities and capabilities to enable them to participate in society as independent, mature and responsible individuals;
- (b) advancing education;
- (c) relieving unemployment

The application must be considered as having a positive impact on the public.



Completion of page 5 of application form and full supporting documentation must accompany all applications. As long as the application fulfils these it will be considered.

Making an application is no guarantee of success in being awarded a grant and each application is reviewed on its own merits. Please therefore provide as much information and support documentation as you can with your application.

Conditions of Grant Awards

There are conditions attached to being awarded a grant and these are:

- 1) **Purpose** - A grant will be awarded on the understanding that it will be used only for the purpose stated in the application form and you are required to provide evidence of this as and when required by the One Me grant auditing panel.
- 2) **Giving Back** – if you are awarded a grant a condition of this award is that you will be willing to help the Charity going forward to reach other young people and help them in the way you have been helped. This may take the form (but not limited to) being a fund raiser or volunteer for One Me, asking your employer to consider One Me as their company charity, providing testimonials on how funding helped you to achieve your goals.
- 3) **Feedback** – you are expected to provide regular feedback on your progress. We will send you a feedback form to complete and return at regular intervals.
- 4) **Appeal Process** – the Trustees decision is final, there is no appeal process should your application be declined.
- 5) **PR** – by accepting your grant award you agree to assist One Me with publicising One Me, this may take the form of (but not restricted to) interviews, photos and case study material
- 6) **Verification of Application** – By sending your application to us either by post or online, you give us permission to contact relevant 3rd parties to verify your details.

By accepting a grant from One Me, you are accepting these conditions and agree to abide by them.

If you are under 18

If you are under the age of 18 at the time of making your application for grant funding, parental/guardian consent will be sought before the grant is awarded and

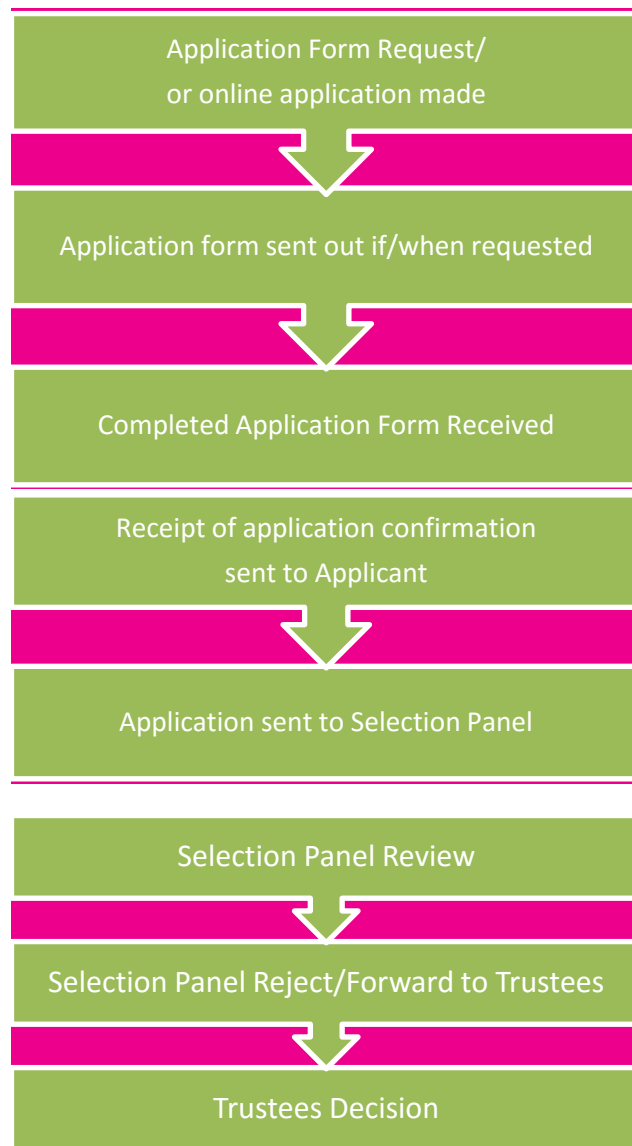


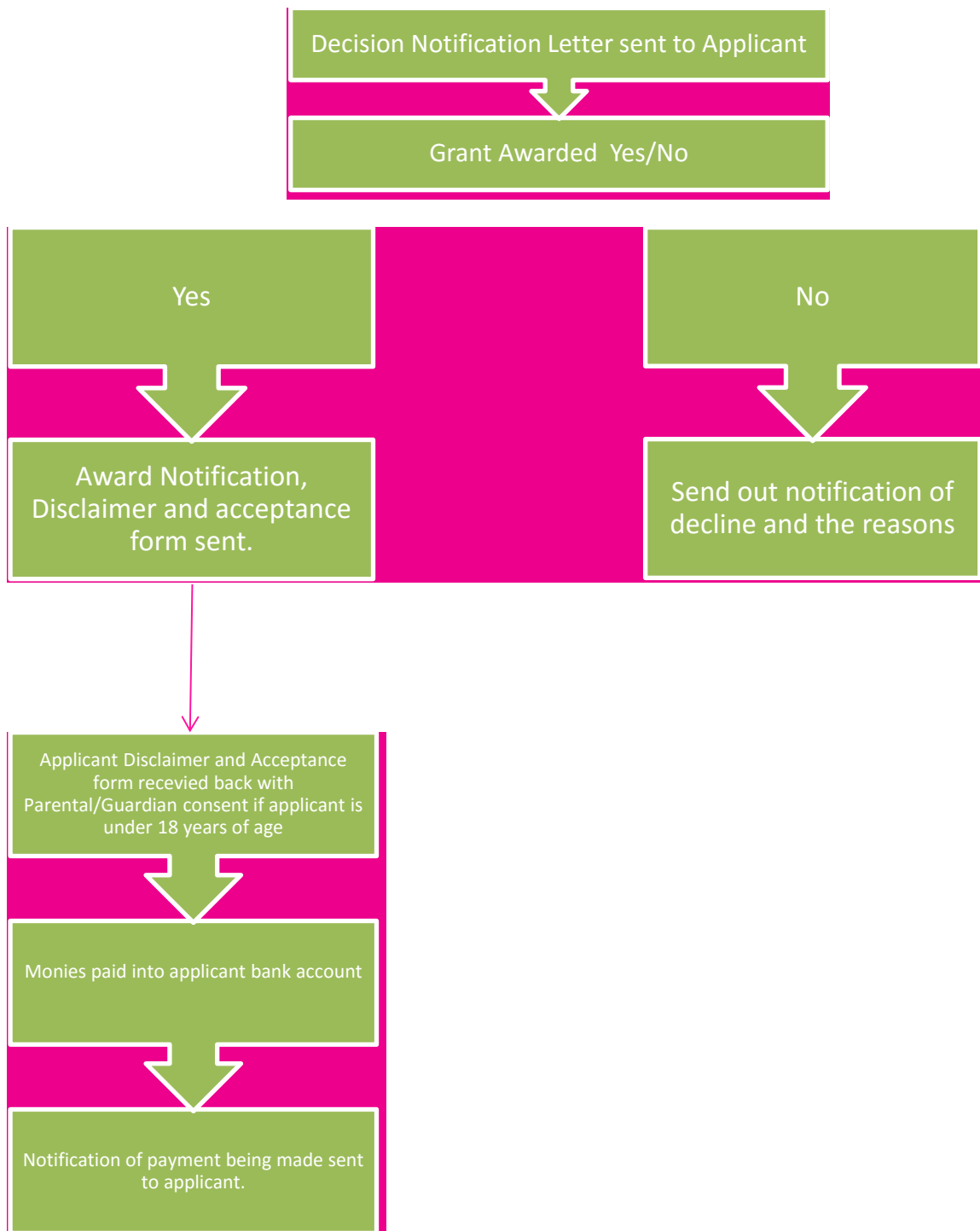
any funds are paid. Should a parent/guardian refuse to give consent the offer of the grant will be withdrawn.
